


Sticky Wall

Have fun with this indispensable tool for every facilitator: the Sticky Wall (3 x 1.5 m): the self-adhesive fabric that offers a large work surface for guiding groups with the methods of ICA's Technology of Participation (ToP®), presentations and all other forms of (visual) facilitation. Made of strong, lightweight and durable material (ripstop nylon), this cloth is ideal to take along and easy to hang.

ToP® methodologies help to realize energetic, productive, inclusive and meaningful participation. Structured participation provides a deeper level of involvement, making the best use of the group's wisdom, creating ownership and making joint decisions.



The advantages of the sticky wall:

- A large work surface that allows you to hang and move large flip-charts and small papers.
- Ideal in situations where you want to group written ideas on paper and regroup them.
- It is light and extremely durable.
- It can be used again and again and it is easy to transport.

Tips for use:

- To stick your sticky wall, spray the sticky wall (the front!) With Repositionable Spray Mount, preferably the 3M brand. This spray is available in the better office supplies trade.
- In order to make good use of the fabric, good injection is important for the first time. Make sure that the entire fabric is lying on the floor. To prevent spray coming on the ground, place newspapers under the edges of the cloth. Then you spray the canvas with a few layers. Follow the instructions on the spray can for the correct distance between the spray can and the cloth and the correct waiting time between sprays. Spray in a well-ventilated area.
- You can repaint the sticky wall as often as needed to generate extra sticky power, but this is not necessary for every use. You can also inject the sticky wall while it is hanging on the wall. Make sure that there is paper on the ground so that no glue ends up on the ground. The sticky wall is ready when it is sticky enough to hold paper, but it is not difficult to pick them up again.
- To use the sticky wall; attach it to a wide, flat wall with a wide paper tape. Make sure you adjust the choice of tape to the surface. Pay attention that it is easy to remove from the wall and the cloth.
- To prevent paper from drifting from the fabric, position the sticky wall flat against the wall and away from airflows.
- To keep the sticky wall clean, always fold the sticky wall with the sticky side on the inside; make sure that the sticky side does not touch the ground or other dusty surfaces.
- It is much easier to hang up the sticky wall and pick up with help, but doing it alone is also possible.
